Only items identified in the application can be sold at the Market.

There will be a booth fee of \$70.00 plus hst for the weekend and a 10% commission on all sales.

Each space is approximately 8 ft. x 6 ft. There is space for 36 booths inside and a limited number outside the Harrison Memorial Hall. Chairs will be provided and tables (8ft x 3ft) can be rented for an additional \$10.00 plus hst.

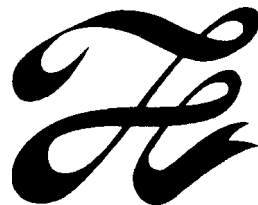
Harrison Festival Society
